

REGULATIONS Please read carefully

1	ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEES
	a. Entries are to be made using the online process by following the 'Run my Festival' link
	from the Festival website <u>www.coulsdonpurleyfestival.co.uk</u> by 31st January 2024.
	b. Entry fees cannot be returned in cases where the date or time of a class proves inconvenient
	to the performer. In the same instance, accompanist fees will not be refunded. Obviously
	detailed timetabling cannot begin until all the entries are received. Fees will only be
	returned if the whole class is withdrawn by the organisers.
	c. If fees are not paid at time of entry, then they must be paid by 31 st January otherwise the
	entry may be withdrawn by the Festival.
	d. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry.
	e. Late entries will not be accepted, and no switching of classes is permitted.
	f. Age categories apply to performers' ages (if 18 or under) on 1 st January 2024.
2.	TIME OF COMPETITION
	a. Festival classes will run from 1 st March to 23 rd March 2024. See the current timetable on the
	Festival website. <u>http://www.coulsdonpurleyfestival.co.uk/time-table.html</u>
	b. A schedule will be issued to entrants once all entries have been collated.
	c. We cannot guarantee which day individual classes will take place and refunds will not be
	offered on that basis – including accompanist fees.
3.	MUSIC
	a. A copy of the piece of music selected by the entrant, must be provided for the Adjudicator
	on the day of the class.
	b. In Speech and Drama classes, a script of the own choice pieces must be provided for the
	Adjudicator.
	c. Performers may not perform more than once in any one solo class.
	d. The same OWN CHOICE pieces may not be performed in more than one class.
	e. Repertoire cannot be changed after the entry deadline has passed.
	f. Performers who have studied with the Adjudicator may not compete.
	g. Photocopies for use by the adjudicator will be accepted provided that the performer has
	already purchased his or her own printed copy. All photocopies will be destroyed by the
	Festival immediately after the event. All relevant copyright laws must be adhered to.
4.	PERFORMANCE
	a. All participants under the age of 16 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED AT ALL TIMES BY an
	adult with parental responsibility.
	b. The Festival encourages an awareness of presentation and urges performers to dress suitably
	and to take a bow at the end of their performance.
	c. The adjudicator's decision, in all matters relating to the result of a class is final.
	d. MARKS will be awarded, and performers will be placed in the following categories
	according to their achievement: MERIT, HONOURS, DISTINCTION AND
	<u>OUTSTANDING.</u> Certificates will be awarded for each category. The winner, runner-up
	and third placed performers in each class may be announced by the Adjudicator except in
	classes where there are 4 or fewer entries where only the winner will be announced. In the
	event of a performer not reaching Merit standard they will be awarded a Certificate of
	Participation.

	e. Classes are open to <u>AMATEURS</u> only; i.e. An amateur is someone who does not derive
	his/her livelihood from the branch of performance defined by the class title, in which he/she
	seeks to enter the festival. In any ensemble, all members must adhere to that principle.
	f. <u>TIME LIMITS</u> stated in the Syllabus must be strictly observed. The adjudicator may, if this
	limit is going to be exceeded, stop the performance once they have made a satisfactory
	assessment of that performance.
	g. The Committee shall have the power to appoint or substitute other adjudicators without
	notice, where this is necessary.
5.	TROPHIES AND AWARDS will be awarded to performers who give the best performance in
	those classes which are eligible for a specific prize, provided that the performance has earned
	an Honours, Distinction or Outstanding Certificate.
	<u>CUP/TROPHY HOLDERS</u> are responsible for the safekeeping of their trophies. Any
	engraving undertaken shall be in an appropriate style and size and at their own expense.
	<u>CUPS AND TROPHIES</u> won at the 2024 Festival should be returned, by arrangement and in
	a cleaned condition, to the Cup Secretary, by <u>6 February 2025 AT THE LATEST</u> by

6.	FESTIVAL RESPONSIBILITIES
	The Festival cannot be held responsible for any injuries sustained by any performer or member
	of the public whilst on Festival premises. The Festival also will not be held responsible for any
	loss or damage to the performers' copies, marksheets or any other property at the Festival.
	Comprehensive Risk Assessments for every venue within the Festival are updated annually.
7.	SAFEGUARDING
	The Festival aims to provide a safe environment for everyone who enters the event and all
	reasonable Health and Safety precautions will be made to ensure the safety of everyone who
